The West Bengal State Council of Higher Education has No Objection towards introduction of Master of Business Administration (MBA) and Master of Computer Applications (MCA) courses in Midnapore City College, Bhadutala, Paschim Medinipur (Self-financed) from the academic session 2024-2025 subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

1. The college authority shall recruit additional faculty members both for MBA and MCA courses before the start of the two courses.
2. The Number of faculty rooms should be increased and to be made more spacious.
3. Number of Library books especially in MBA is to be enhanced. The BRAILLE facility is to be extended to the visually impaired stakeholders of the college.
4. The Wi-Fi access to all the students and at every point of the campus to be created.
5. The hygiene factors and the cleanliness should be taken care by the college authority more frequently.
6. The PWD toilets for the Specially Abled Persons and toilets for transgender must be constructed in the campus as soon as possible.
7. In all respects the college shall abide by the guidelines of the AICTE, the Affiliating University and the State Government orders issued from to time in this regard.


