First Part

Midnapore City College was established in 2017 at Kuturiya, Bhadutala, Midnapore, Paschim Medinipur, West Bengal, Pin - 721129 with the aims:

- To provide facilities for teaching and training students at undergraduate and postgraduate levels in Fishery Science and allied biological disciplines.
- To gain recognition as a centre of excellence in teaching, research, and extension in Fishery Science.
- To conduct training camps, field visits and workshops for students and local stakeholders in fisheries and aquaculture.
- To organize seminars, conferences, and continuing education programs on subjects related to fisheries, aquaculture, aquatic health, and environmental sustainability.
- To prepare and distribute educational and extension materials to update knowledge from grassroots fish farmers to advanced researchers, along with promoting their own research activities.

In consonance with these aims and objectives, Midnapore City College, West Bengal, through its Department of Biological Sciences (Fishery Science), has been actively undertaking various educational, research, and awareness activities. The Department is equipped with laboratories for Fisheries Biology, Fish Parasitology, Water Quality Management, Aquatic Ecology, and Microbiology. In accordance with a mutual desire to promote and develop skill-based educational, training, and research activities between the two institutions - Midnapore City College, Department of Biological Sciences (Fishery Science) and Natural Sciences Foundation, we agree to the following statement of . intent.

The cooperation in specific areas will be designed by mutual consent and incorporated into additional agreements as required upon signature by the appropriate authorities.

General Areas of Interest and Cooperation

The two institutions agree to collaborate in the following general areas:

- Sharing of technical infrastructure and field facilities to enhance practical, skill-based education
- Sharing of intellectual expertise for training programs both theoretical and hands-on.
- Initiation of joint academic and skill-based professional programs.
- Joint organization of workshops, training sessions, seminars, and field demonstrations on aquaculture, integrated farming, fish health, and environmental management.
- Joint promotion of each other's expertise and collaborative capabilities through educational and community outreach.

Scope of Midnapore City College (Fishery Science)

- To run academic programs and skill development workshops in Fishery Science and integrated farming.
- To facilitate student field training, research projects, and internships in collaboration with Neorgan Integrated Farm LLP.
- To organize seminars, awareness camps, and capacity-building programs.

Scope of Natural Sciences Foundation

- To provide hands-on field training, internships, and exposure visits for Fishery Science students.
- To extend technical mentorship on integrated farm operations, including pond and fish health management.
- To host short-term refresher training and demonstration programs on-site.

Financial and Operational Understanding

Both organizations agree that:

- All financial arrangements necessary to implement this MoU or any subsequent agreement will be negotiated according to the regulations of each institution.
- This MoU is intended to establish a foundation of mutual understanding and cooperation and does not it create any immediate financial obligations.

Validity and Modification

- This MoU will take effect from the date of its signing and shall be valid for a period of three (3) years, unless terminated earlier by either institution upon six months' notice.
- This MoU may be modified or extended beyond its initial term by mutual agreement of both parties.
